Human Intervention With Seals Can Kill...



The beaches at Horsey and Winterton are blessed to be home to some of the largest colonies of Grey Seals to be found anywhere. From November to the end of January the beach will be crowded with Seals and their new born pups

THIS IS AN URGENT MESSAGE to please treat these beautiful animals with the ultimate respect they deserve. Human intervention can easily prove fatal to Seals and in particular their Pups – so please ensure you adhere to the following rules when visiting the beach:

KEEP YOUR DISTANCE - Maintain a distance of **AT LEAST 10 metres** between you and the seals – they are wild animals

NEVER come between a pup and their mother. Approaching Seal pups may lead the mother to abandon the Pup

WALKING YOUR DOG? Always keep it on a close lead – to keep both your dog and the seals safe. Seals are protective of their pups and will bite if approached

DON'T CHASE seals or their pups into the water. Seal pups, while white, are not waterproof until they first moult and are likely to drown

DON'T TAKE SELFIES AND KEEP YOUR DISTANCE—SEALS ARE WILD ANIMALS
